#### **Terms and Conditions**

- Materials issued to students as part of the SRS are to be kept in good condition.
- The teacher is to be notified immediately of the loss of any materials
- All texts provided under the SRS remain the property of the school and must be returned when a student transfers from the school, or at the end of the year.
- The SRS is a total package and parents who participate are required to commit to all areas within the scheme.
- A receipt will be issued for all monies paid.
  Students who start throughout the year will be charged on a pro-rata basis.
- Students who transfer from the school throughout the year will receive a pro-rata refund.
- Any resources negligently damaged or lost must be replaced by the parent before any additional resources will be issued to the student.
- Every child receives exactly what they need when they need it. Children therefore do not waste valuable learning time when a small number of children do not have their items.

- Parents have a hassle-free start to the year.
- Expensive resources are purchased by the school so parents share the cost over several years.
- Parents do not waste money buying the wrong item.
- Teachers have flexibility with the resources.
- Students have ready access to teacher prepared booklets/ work sheets.

#### What is Provided

- Use of reading books and home readers.
- Classroom materials and equipment.
- Enhanced learning resources for curriculum areas.
- All class notes/ worksheets.
- All art and craft supplies.
- Stationery Items
   – scissors x 1, pencils x 40, felt pens x 24, crayons x 2 packs, exercise books x 2, scrap books, x 6 paint brushes, rulers, etc.
- Use of computer software

## **Policy and Guidelines**

- The Student Resource Scheme (SRS) operates in accordance with section 51 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006
- The school operates the SRS to reduce the costs of textbooks, other learning materials and to provide quality learning resources to students.
- The SRS has been established by Crescent Lagoon State School and is overseen by the school's Finance Committee.

## What does my child receive when I join the SRS Scheme?

- The use of reading books and home reading books.
- Subscription to online program.
- · Classroom materials and equipment.
- All art and craft supplies.
- All stationery Items (as required throughout the year) scissors, pencils, felt pens, crayons, exercise books, scrap books, paint brushes, rulers, etc. You will need to supply your own writing implements for homework.
- Use of computer software.

#### How is the cost of the SRS determined?

The scheme offers parents an economical alternative to the purchase of school resources, learning resources and books to enhance and maximise your child's learning outcomes. *Key Learning Areas* and *Classroom programs are also allocated funding by the school.* Through the SRS, the school is able to offer a very cost-effective option for parents to support their child's educational resource needs.

# IF JOINING SRS THE COST IS REDUCED TO: \$110

This levy covers ongoing resource costs in 2023. It <u>does not</u> cover personal items such as a Library Bag, swimming outfit, old shirt for painting.

School policy is that school fees need to be paid before students can participate in out-of-school activities eg: excursions.

## Why do we ask for payment EARLY TERM 1 2023

We require the Student Resource Scheme payment early in Term 1 in the 2023 school year so that student learning materials and books may be purchased early and discounts secured, through early payment and bulk ordering. We are also able to ensure students will have access to their resources when they commence school.
