## This funding will be used to

- Provide STEM funding to increase engagement of students with 85%-95% attendance by providing STEM / Robotic programs at school. Target students achieving A/B in Math and English.
- Funding will be used to employ Head of Curriculum (0.5 FTE) to ensure a clear and sequenced curriculum alignment and line of sight from prep to year 6.
- Increase teacher aides time allocated in classrooms to work alongside teachers to build capability and capacity.
- Purchase Smart Boards to replace existing ones in 100% classrooms to improve teaching and learning.
- Purchase laptops, pod and iPads for year 6 and prep classes.

## Our initiatives include

- Building capability of teacher aides to develop skills working alongside teachers to improve learning outcomes for students.
- Expanding and providing pathways for STEM programs with a focus on achieving A/B in English and Math.
- Resourcing and purchasing digital technology to improve student participation and achievement.
